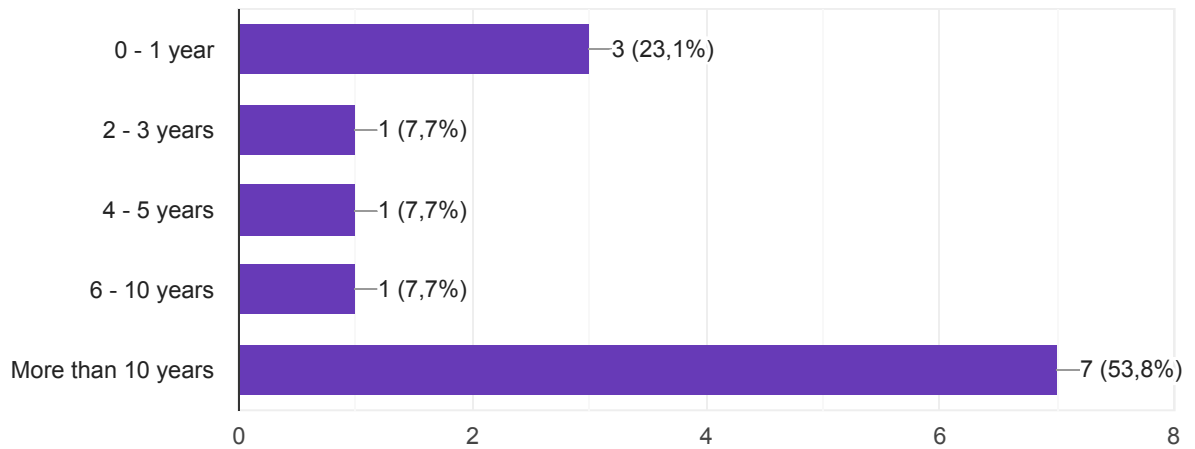

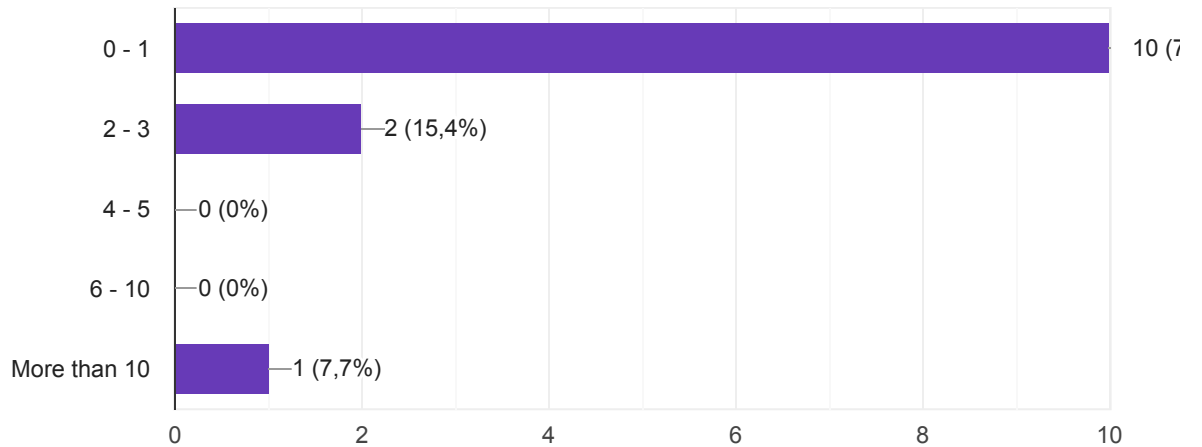
### 2. Number of years of experience you have with including students with disabilities in your classroom.

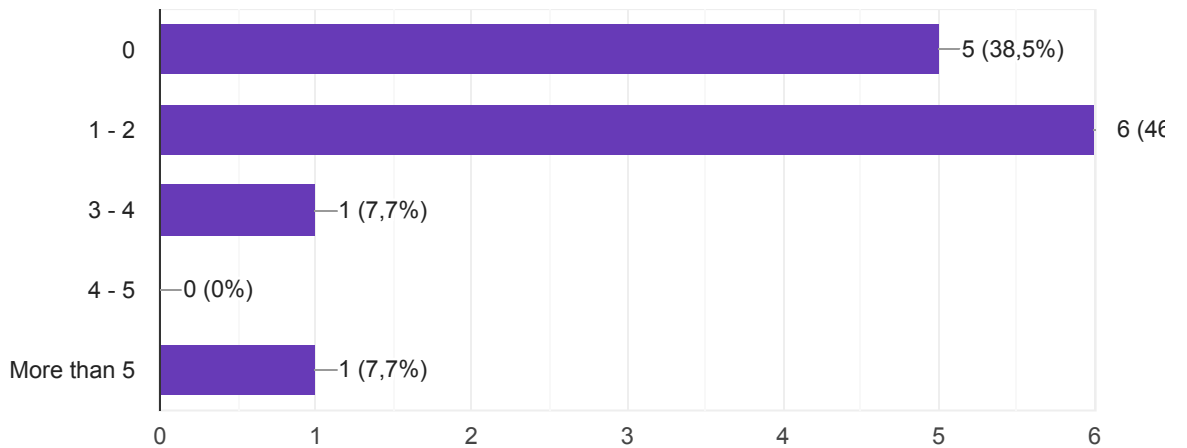

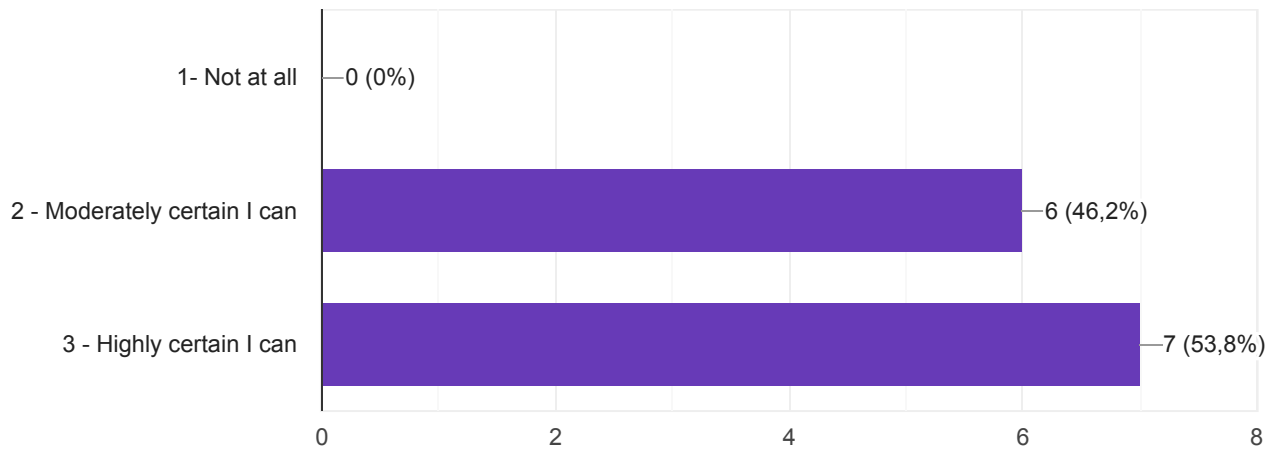

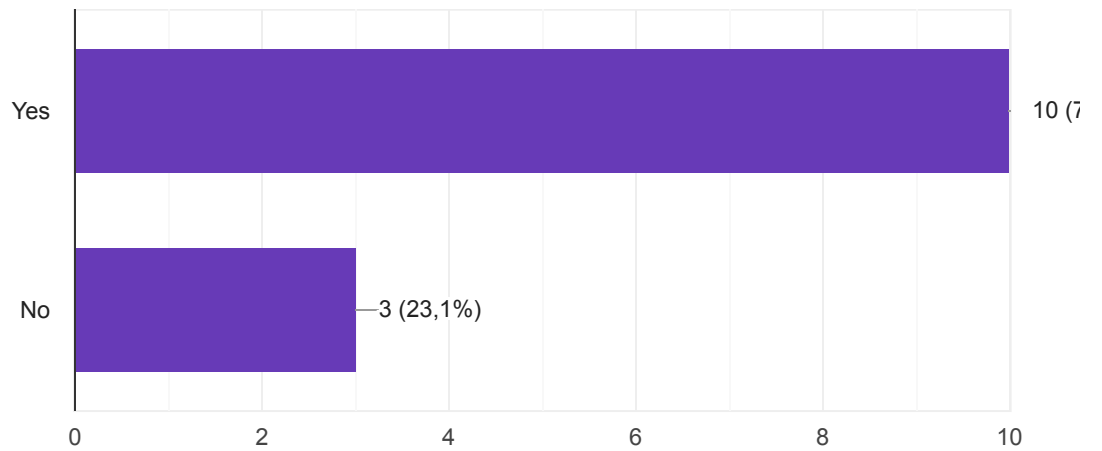

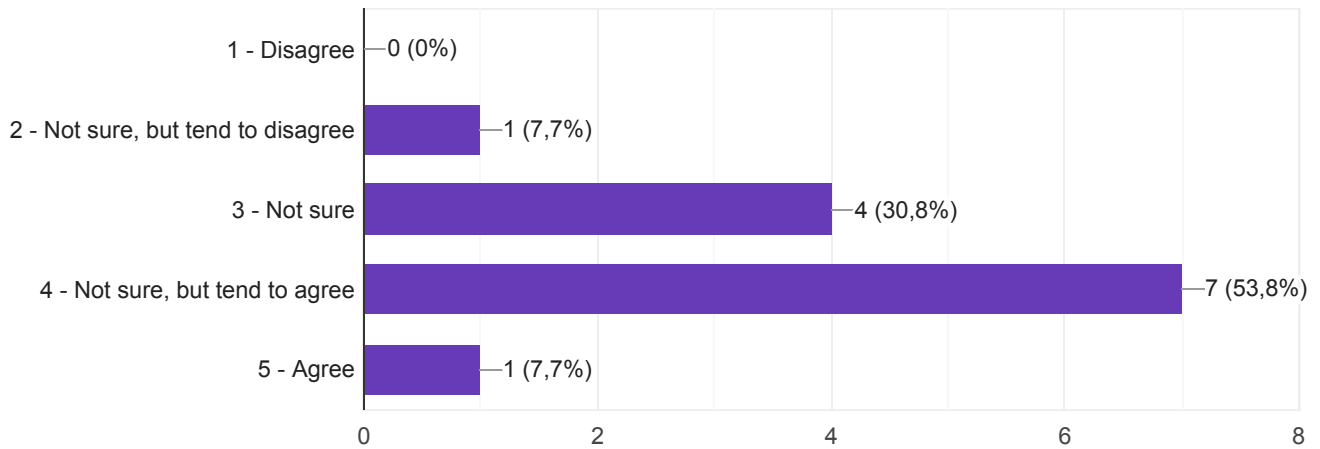

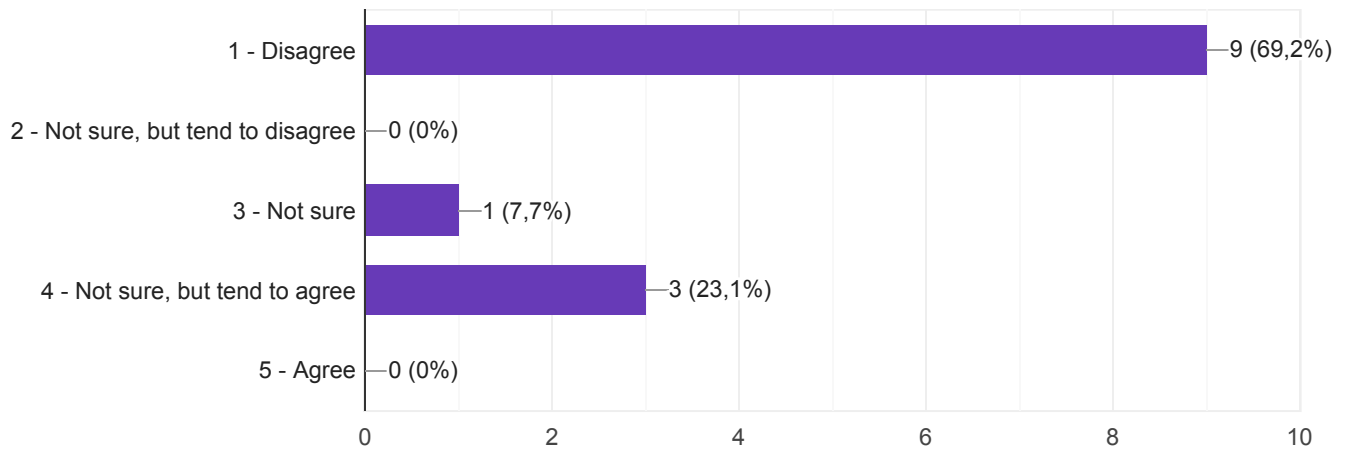

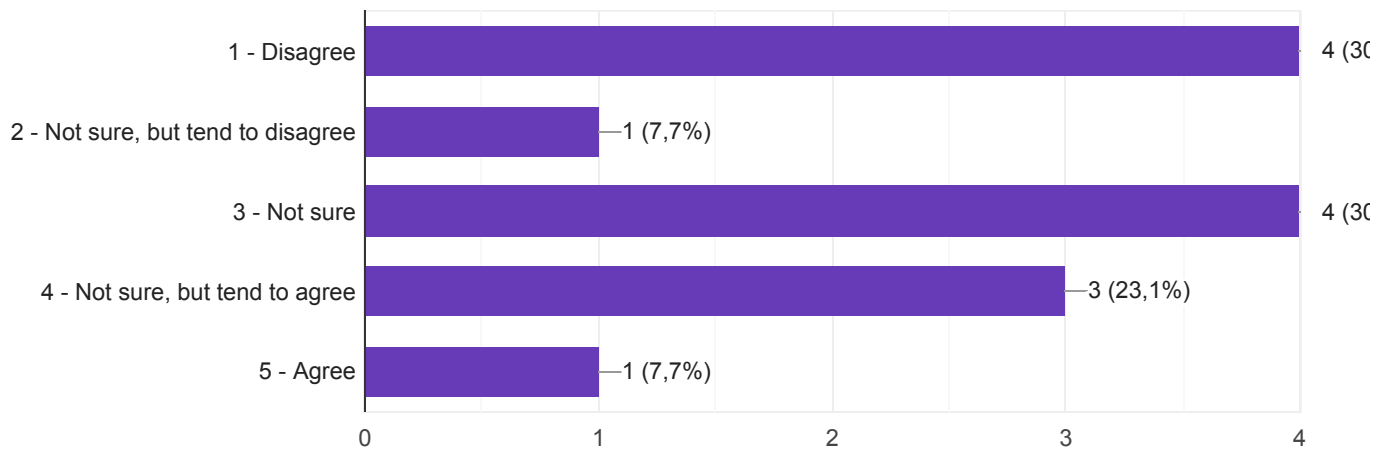

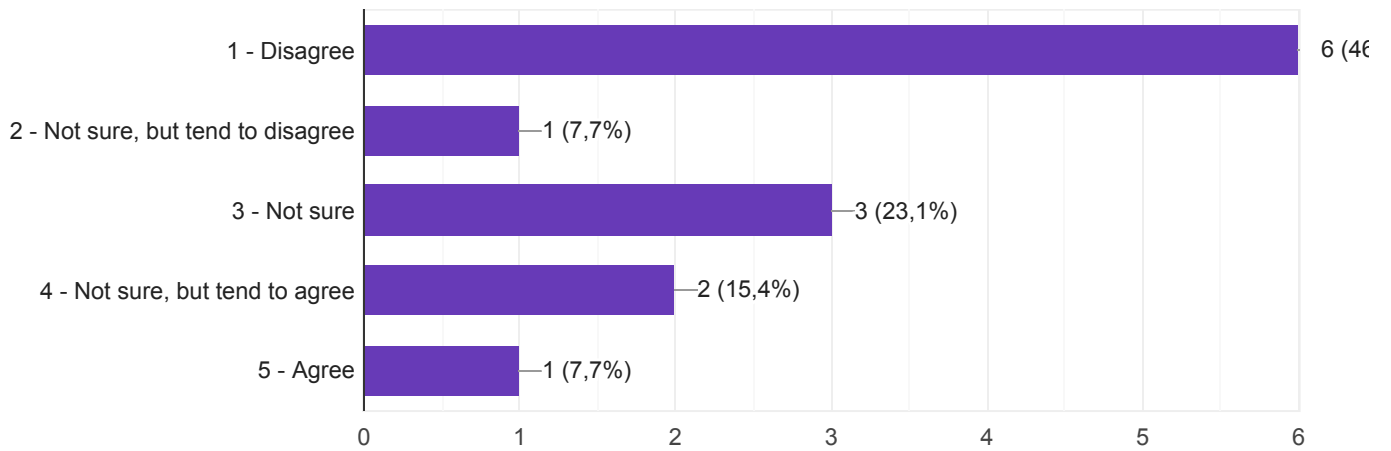

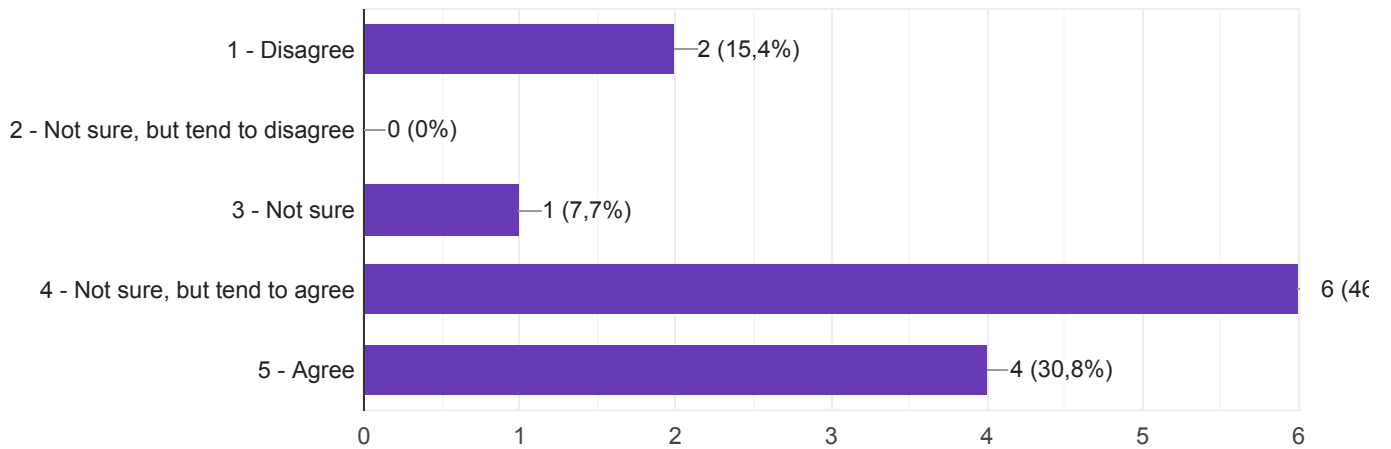

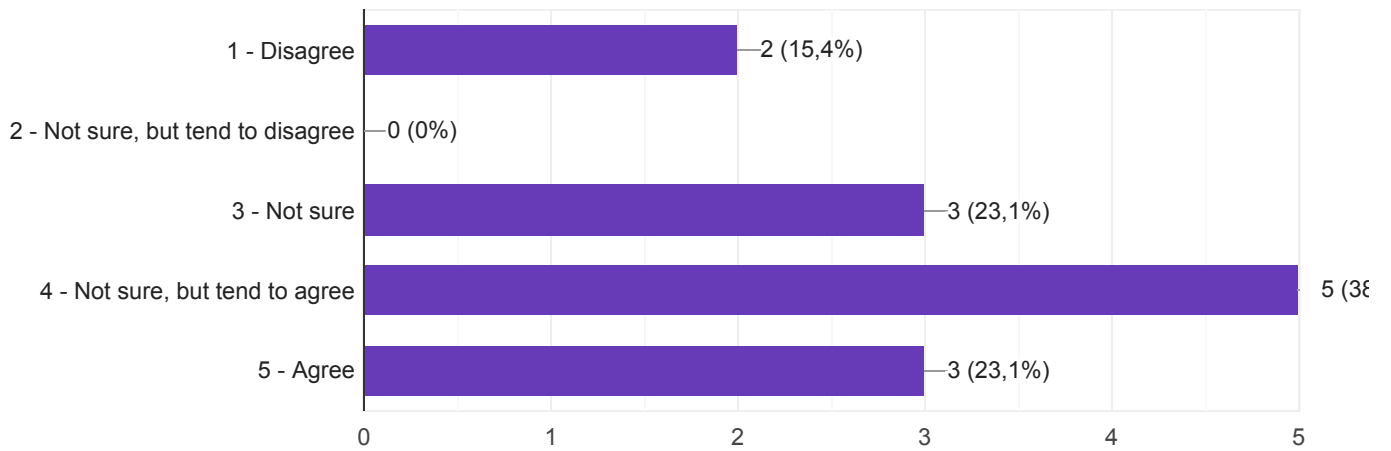

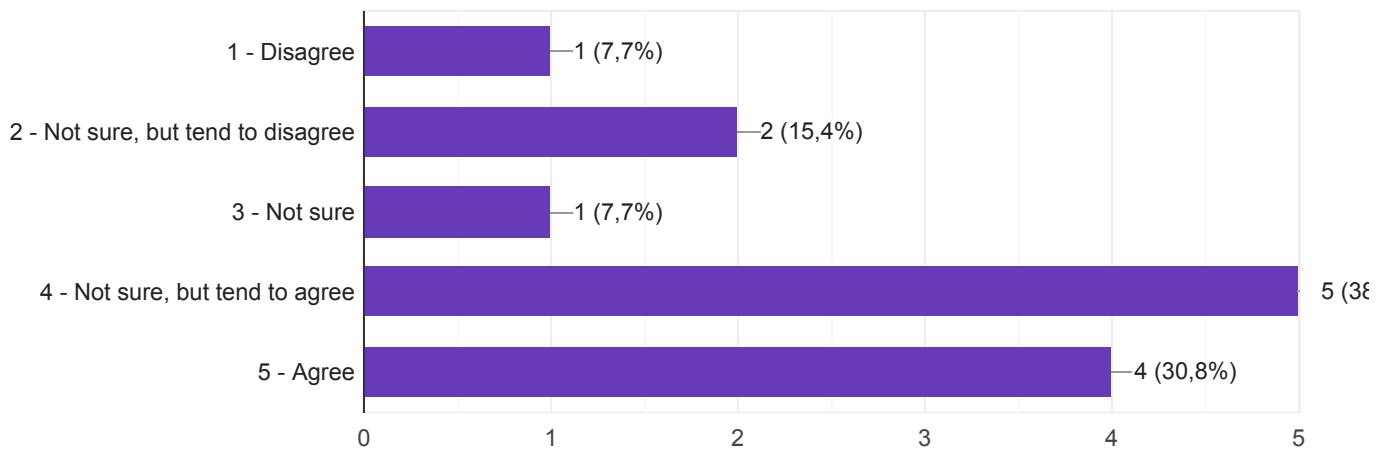

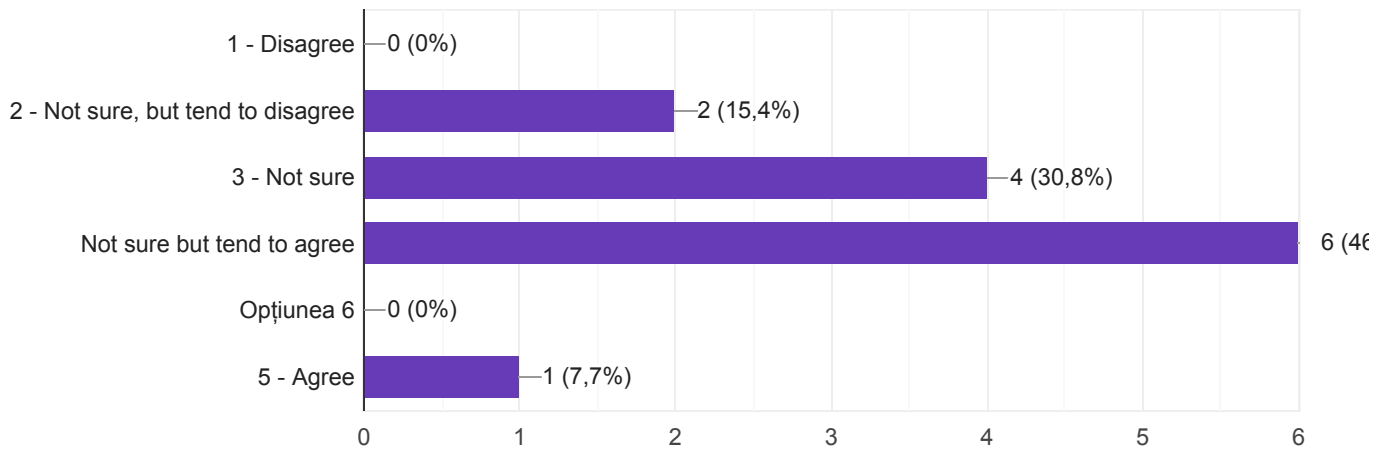

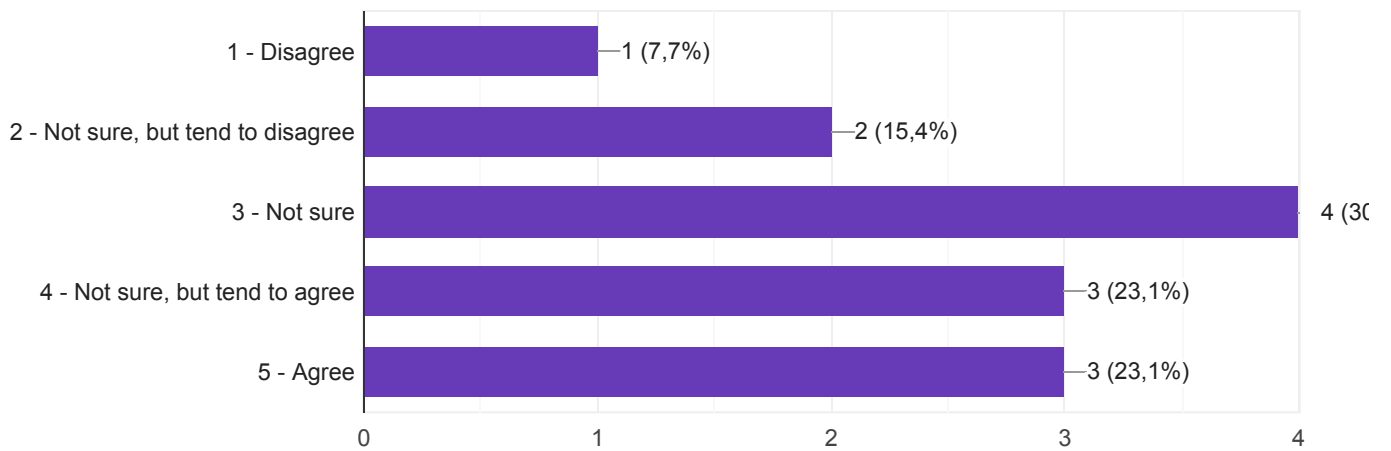

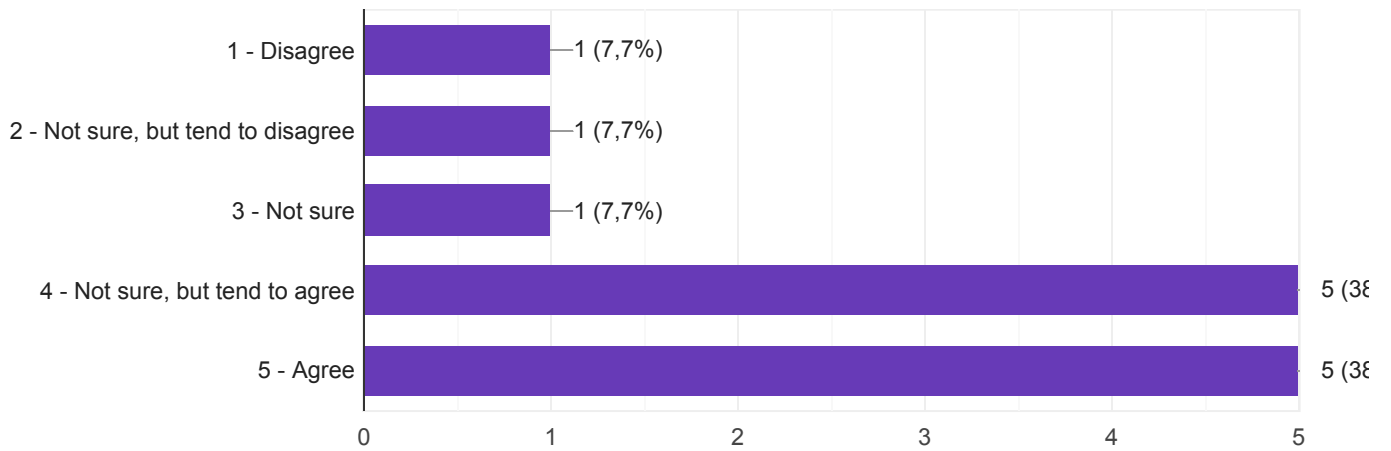

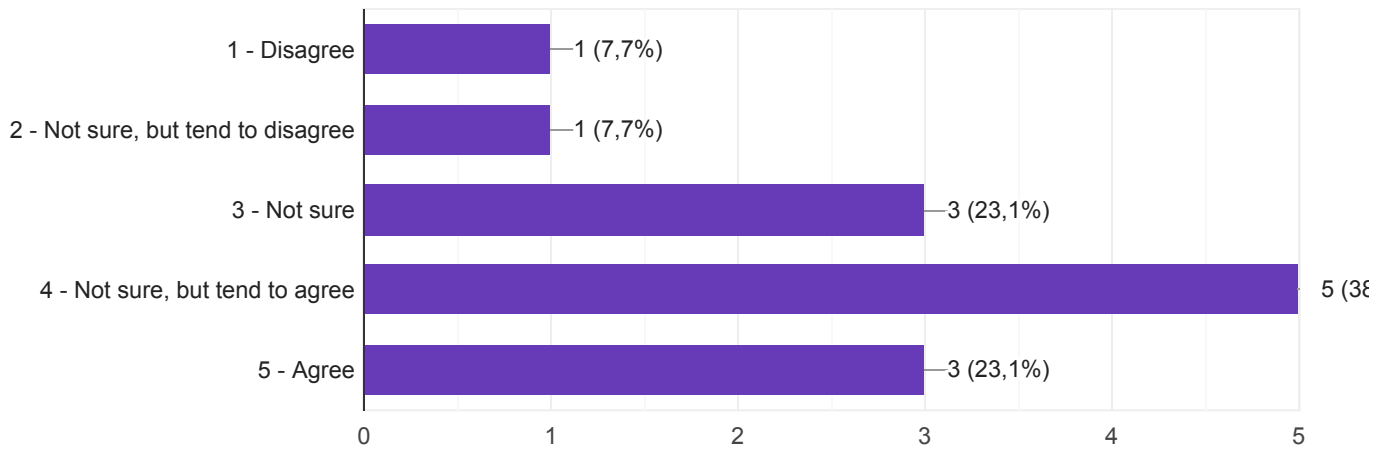

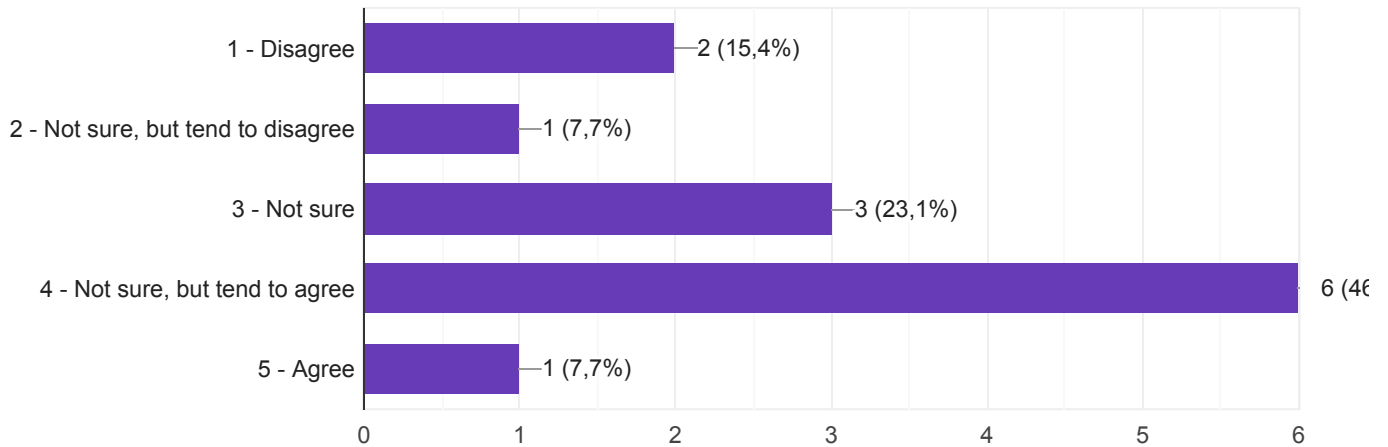

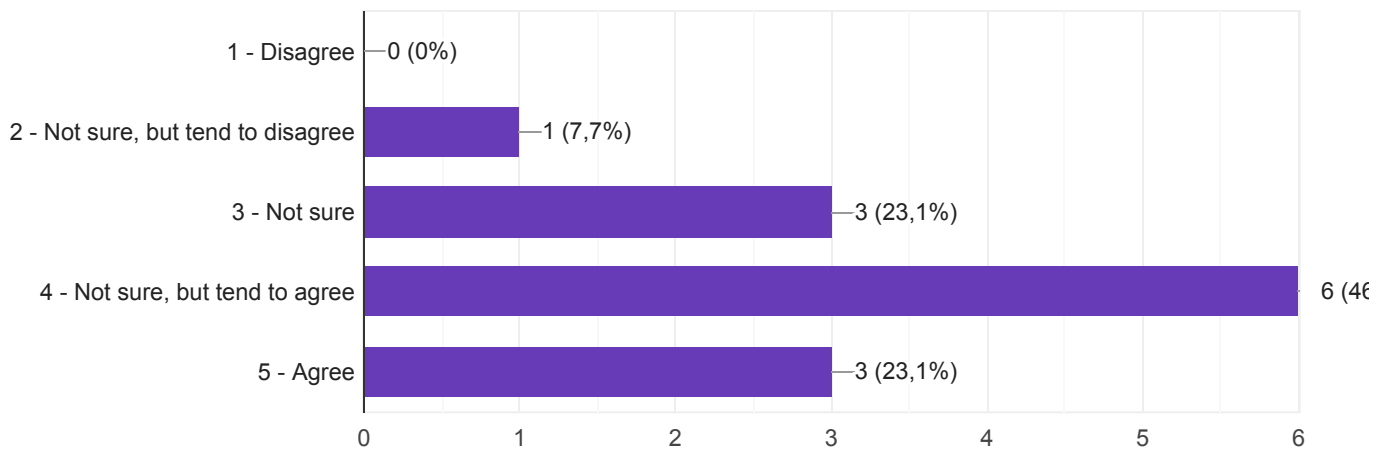

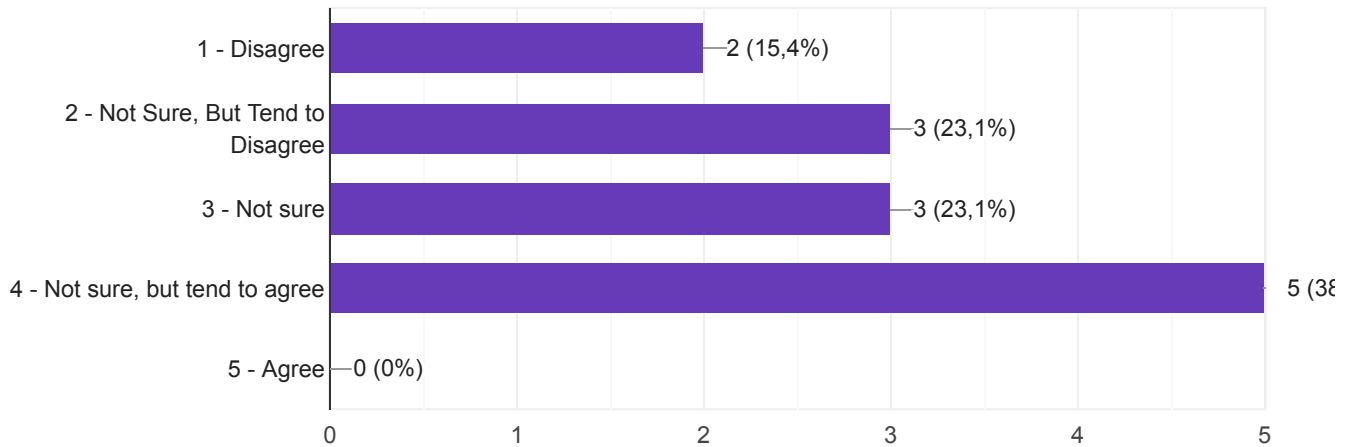

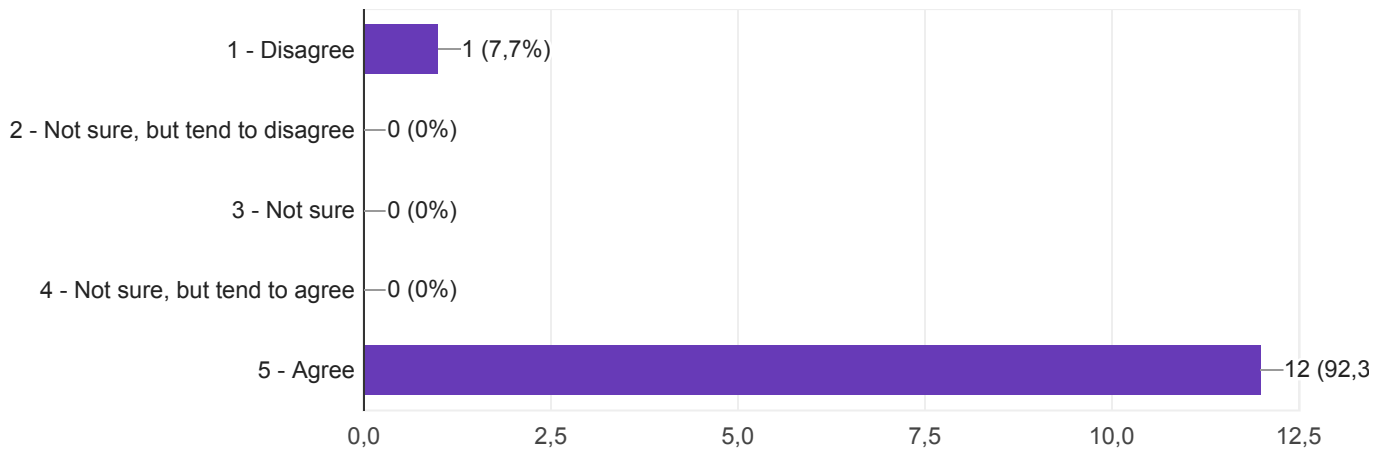

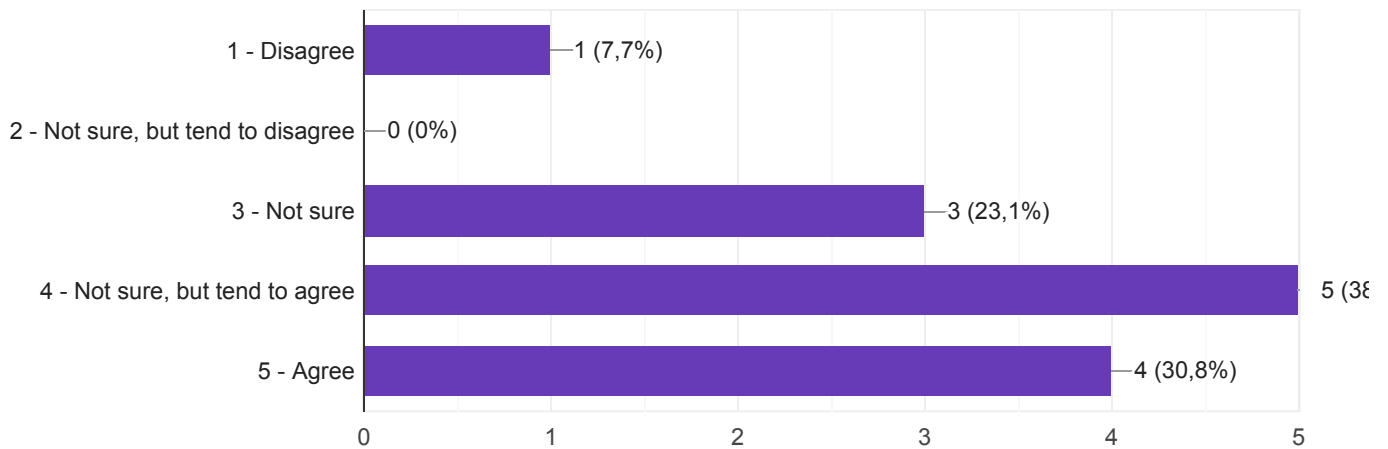

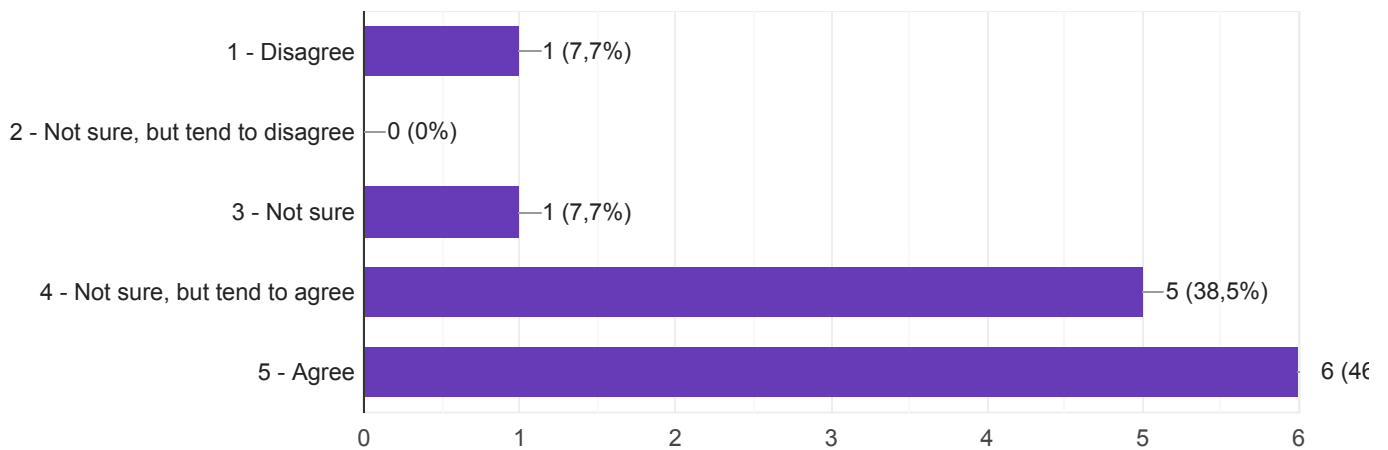

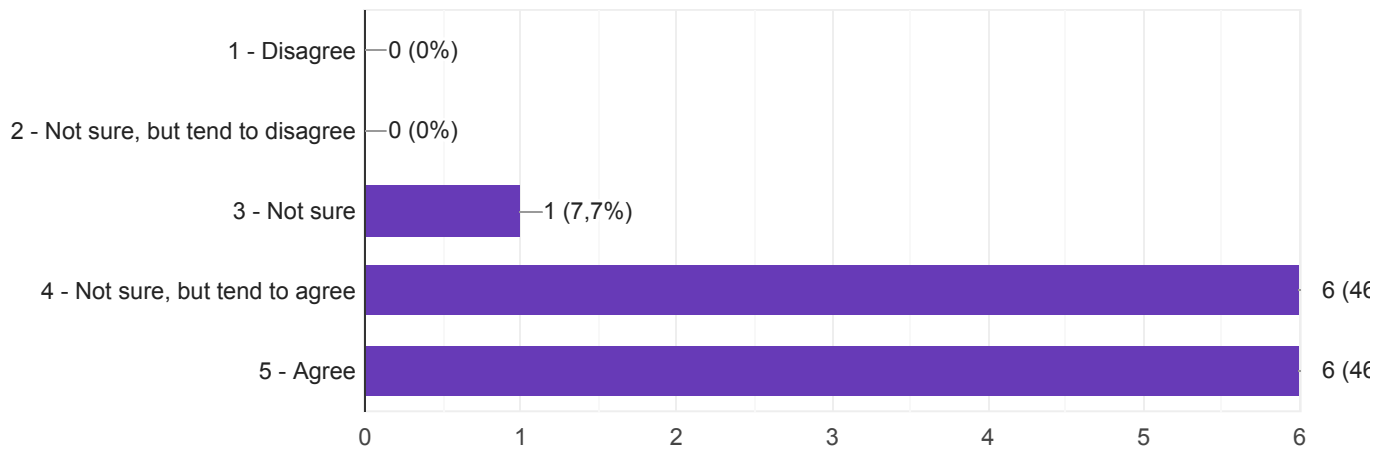

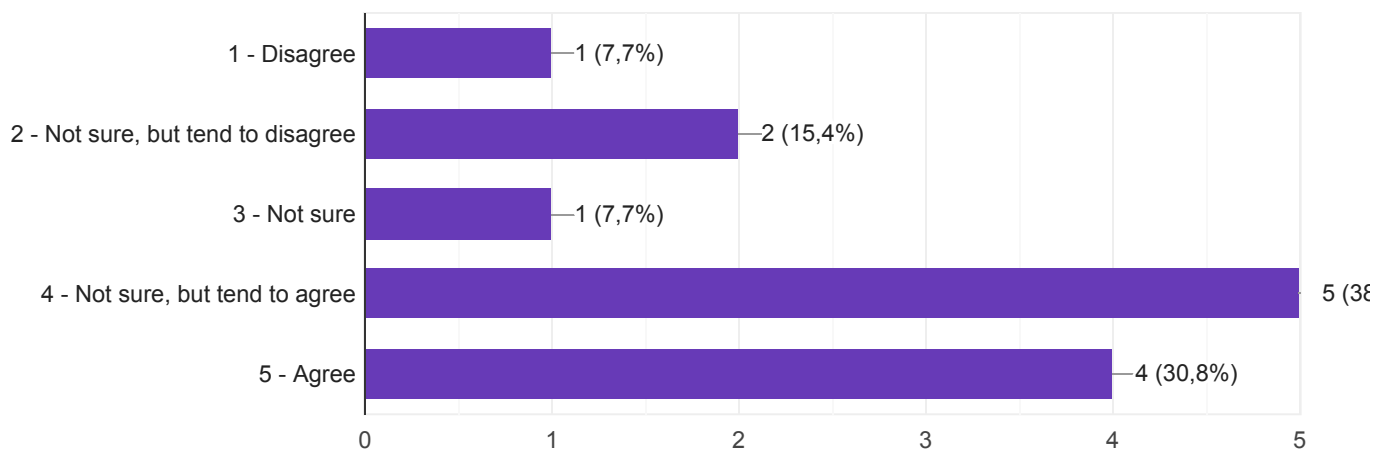

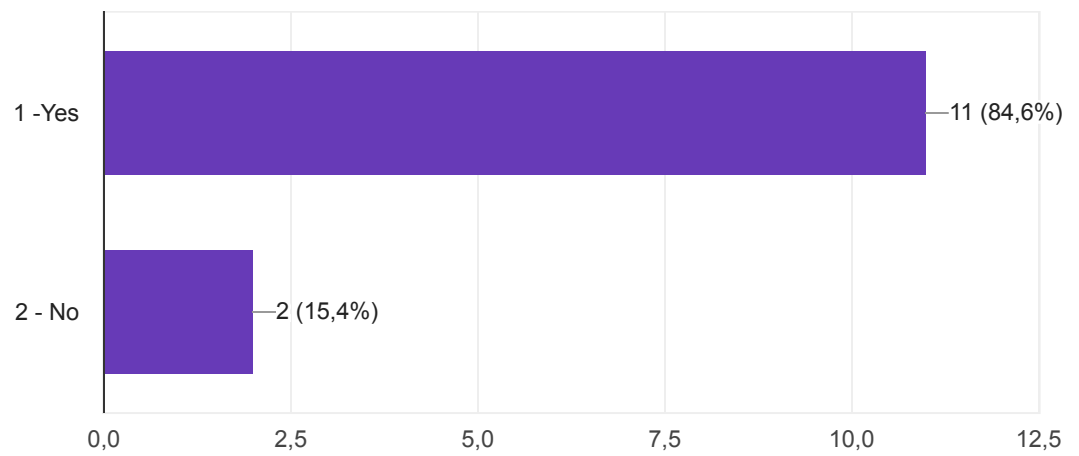

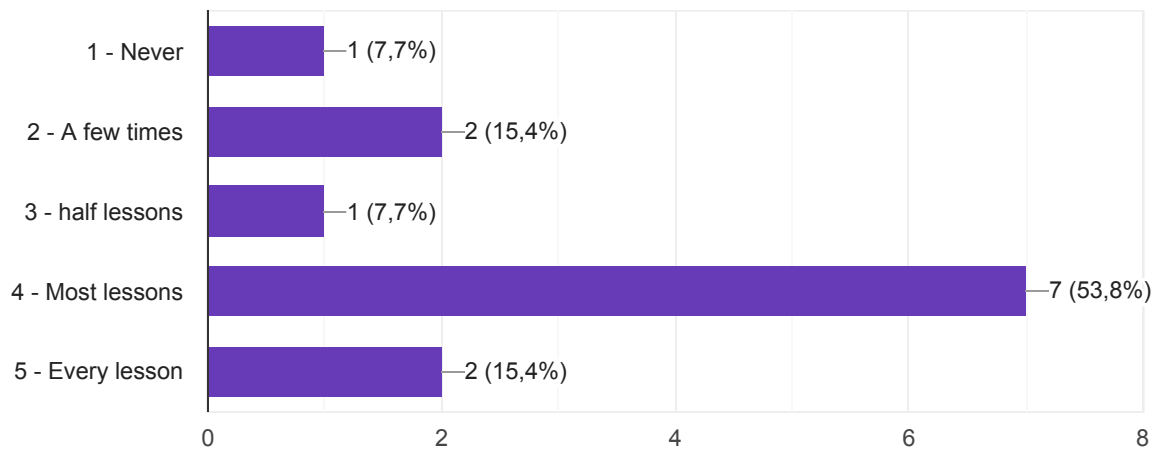

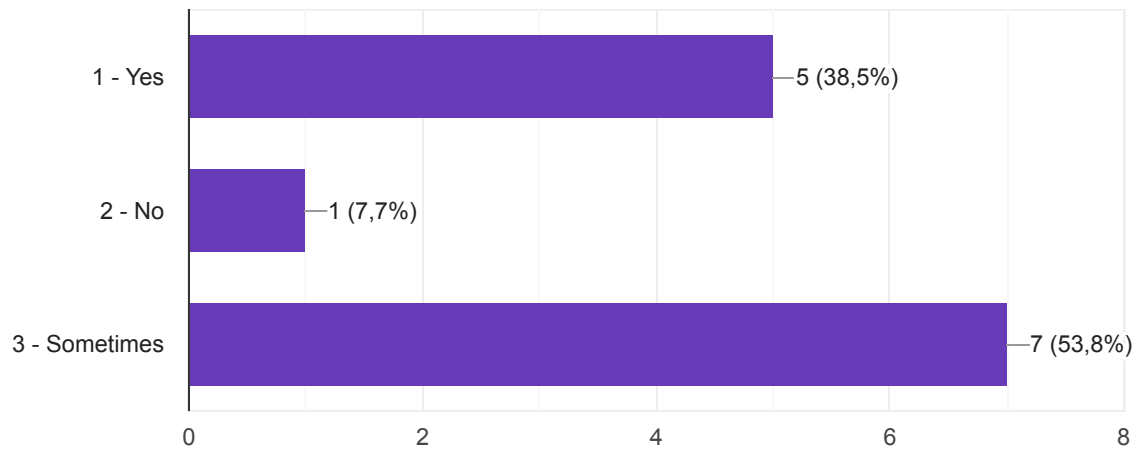

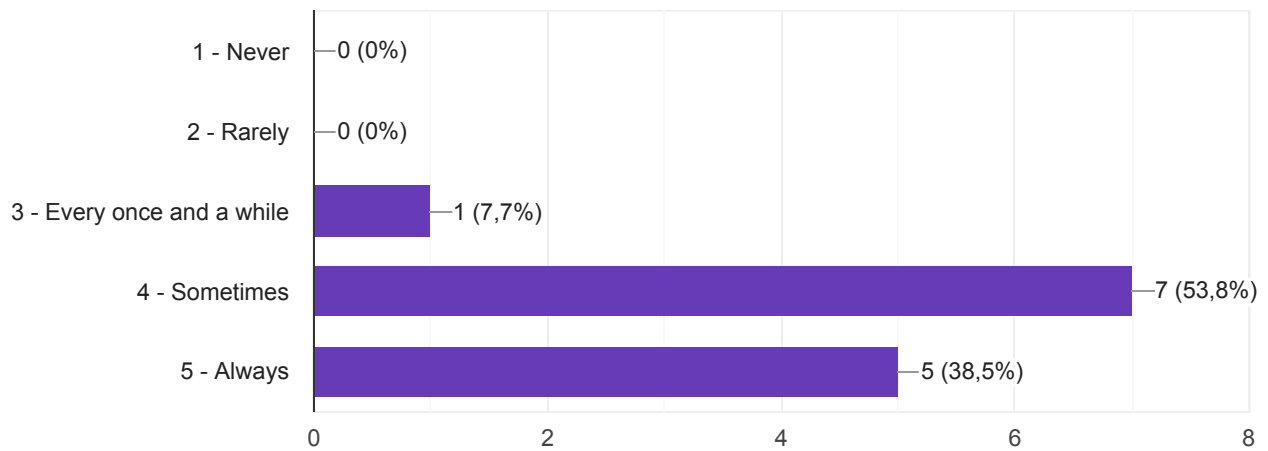

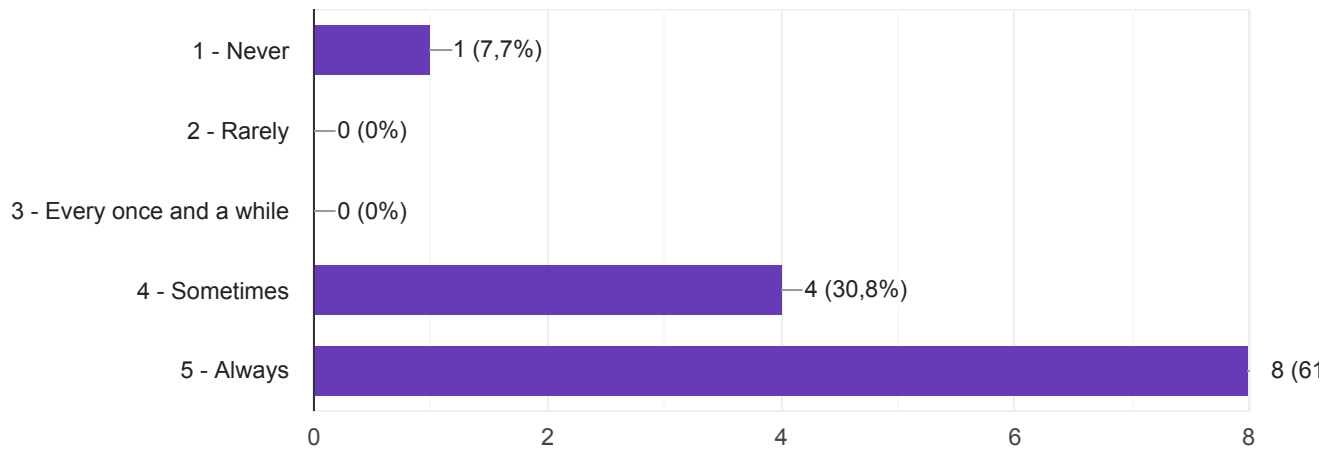

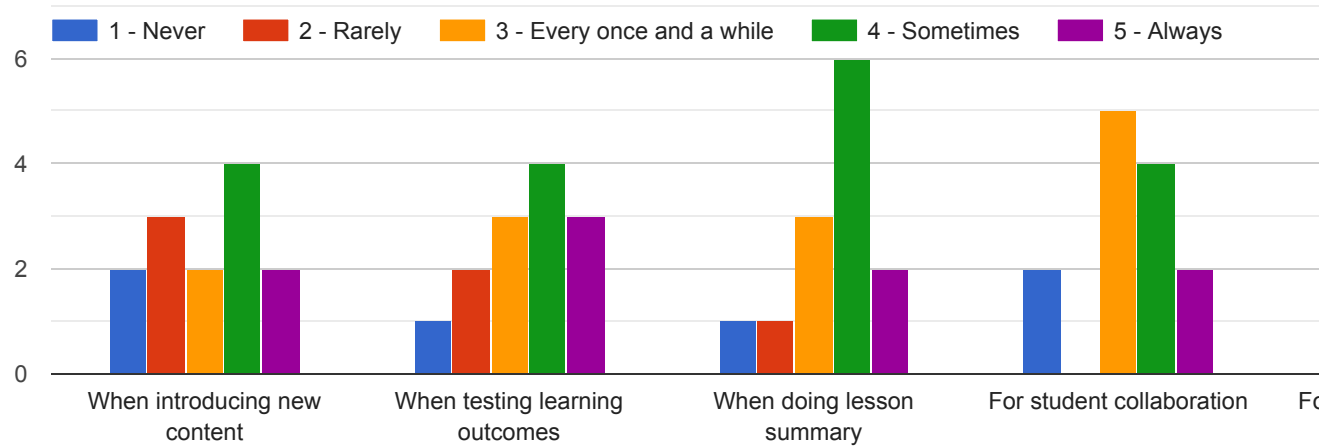

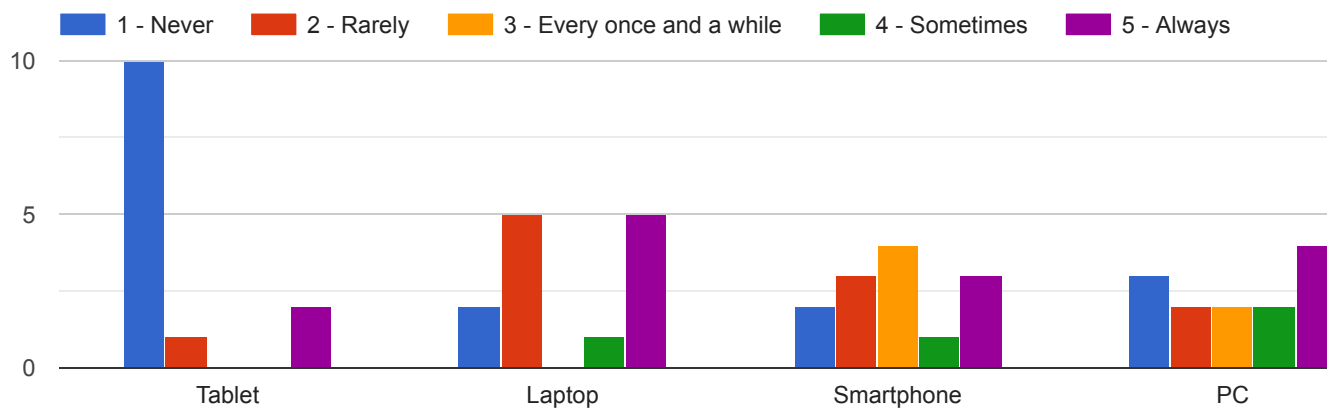

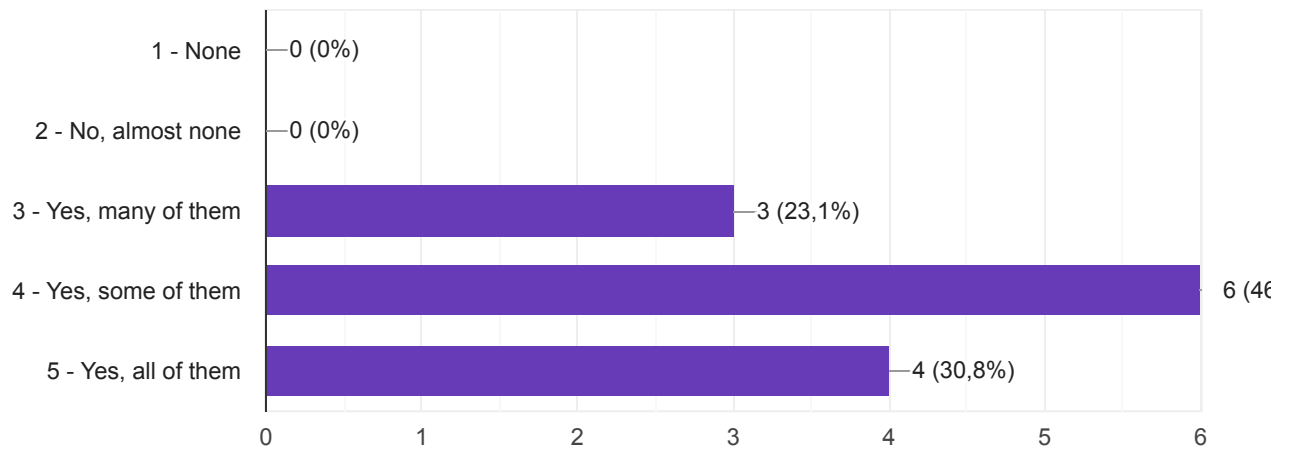


### 35. While preparing for classes which device do you use most often?



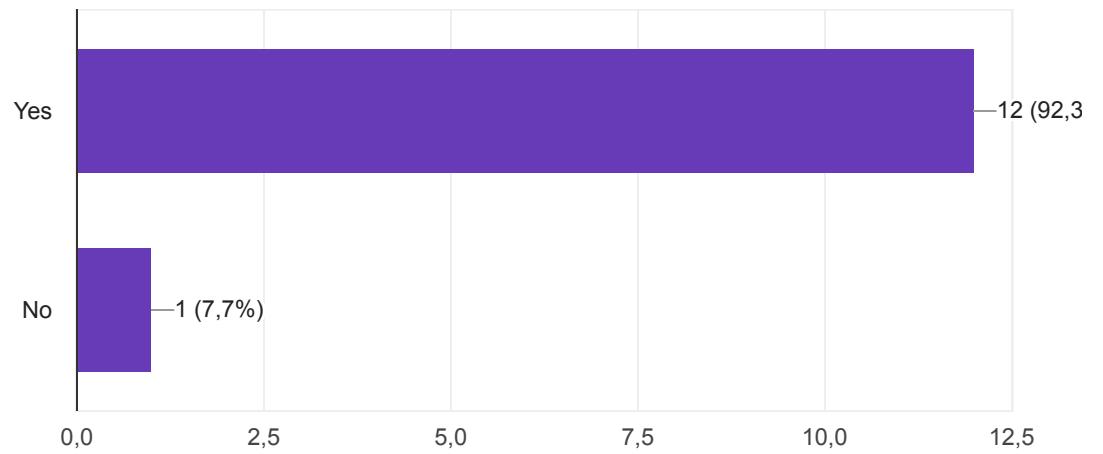

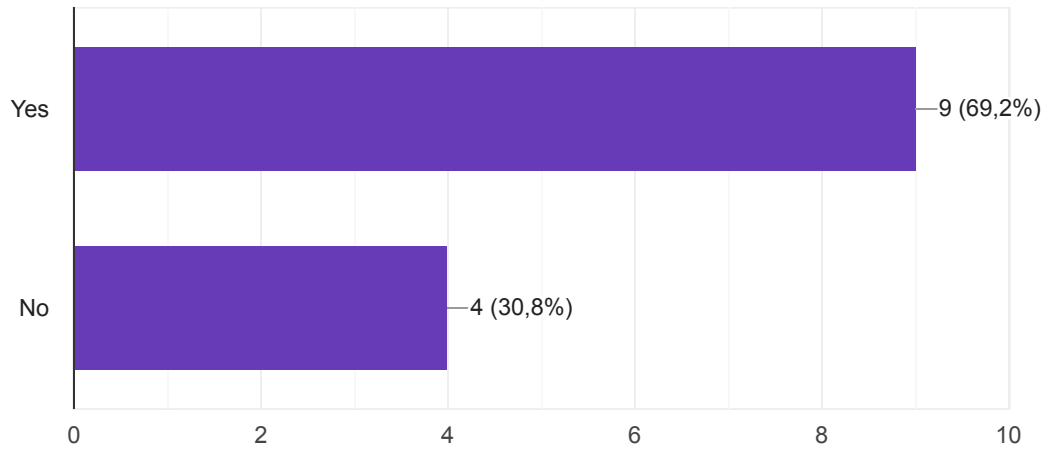

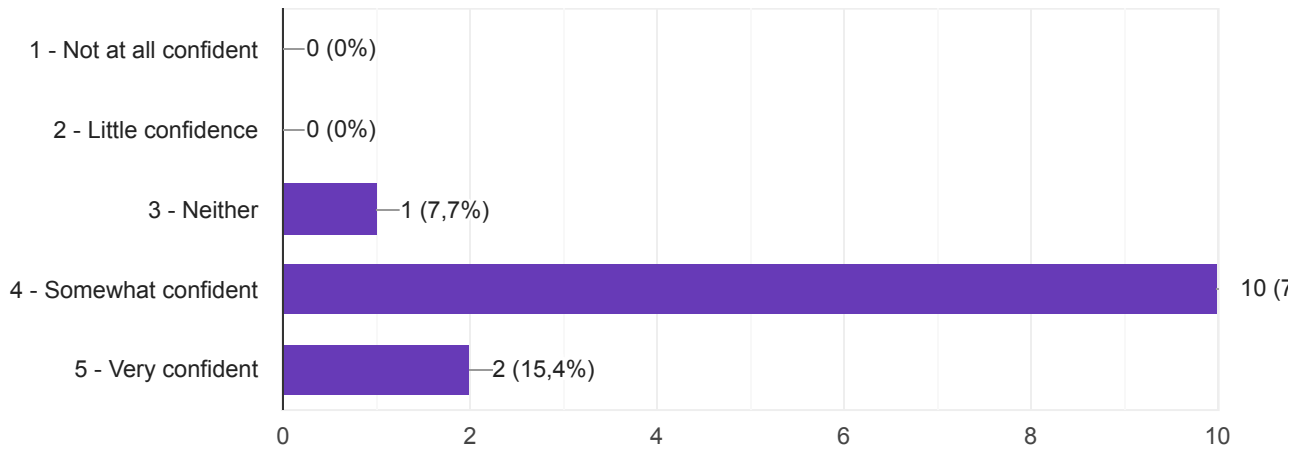
